



## **Guelph Lakes Golf Club Course Information**

**Dress Code-** While we do encourage a relaxed atmosphere, golfers are asked to wear appropriate clothing while at the club, both on the course and driving range. Tank tops and halter tops are not allowed, shorts and skirts should be an appropriate length.

**Outside Alcohol-**No outside alcohol is allowed in accordance with the club's liquor license. Any outside alcohol will be confiscated and golfers risk removal from the property.

**On Course Beverage Service-**We do not operate a beverage cart and our on course station is open during tournaments only. Drinks may be purchased at the clubhouse before and after your round and after 9 holes. We encourage golfers to bring their own water bottle with them.

**Pace of Play-**Pace of play should take a **maximum of 4 hours and 15 minutes**. This timing is based on a group of 4 walking golfers. Pace of play is strictly enforced, any groups falling behind this pace will be spoken to by a player assistant and expected to make every effort to get back on pace. Pace of play is enforced to ensure all players have an enjoyable day on the course.

**Course Maintenance-**Our grounds crew works tirelessly to provide the best conditions possible, please respect the work they do and help maintain the course. It is the golfer's responsibility to repair ball marks, replace divots, rake bunkers and drive carts responsibly and only in the areas allowed.

**Tee Times-**The course will make every effort to have 4 players in each tee time. Groups booked with less than 4 players should expect to be paired with additional golfers. If you would like to assure that you are not paired up you are welcome to pay for all 4 spots in that tee time.

**Rental Clubs-**Rental clubs are not available for the golf course or driving range. Golfers are allowed to share clubs at the range however each golfer must have their own set of clubs to play the course.

**Rain Checks-**The course will issue a full 18 holes rain check to any golfers that have completed less than 5 holes. A 9 holes rain check will be issued to golfers completing 5-14 holes. No rain check will be issued to golfers that have teed off the 15<sup>th</sup> hole.

**Severe Weather-**The course does not have a weather warning in place and we do not sound a horn for threatening weather. Golfers are to use their own discretion when threatening weather approaches and should cease play and head to a rain shelter or return to the clubhouse. If the course becomes unplayable due to weather conditions golfers will be notified and asked to return to the clubhouse.

**Driving Range Hours**-The driving range is closed from Tuesday at 5:00pm until Wednesday at 11:00 am each week for maintenance and grass cutting. Regular Range hours will be adjusted dependant on daylight.
